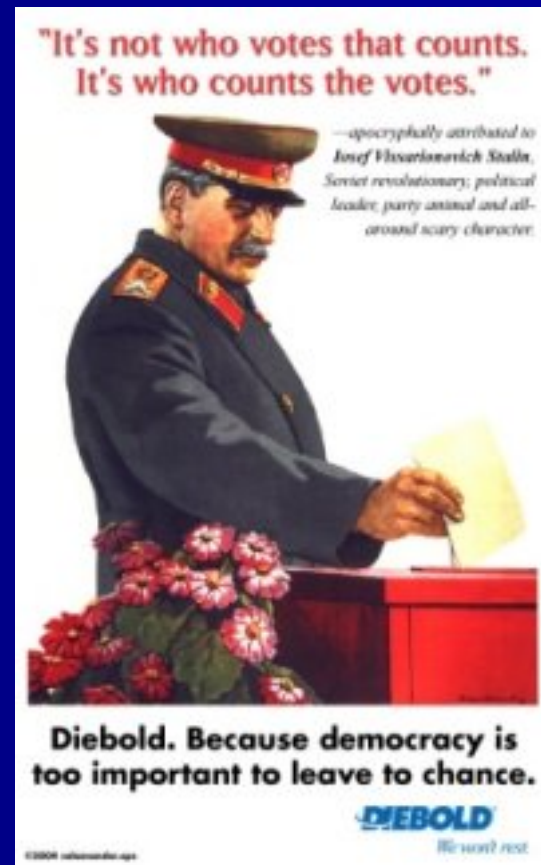


NH's Diebold Vote Counting Computers Designed by Criminals

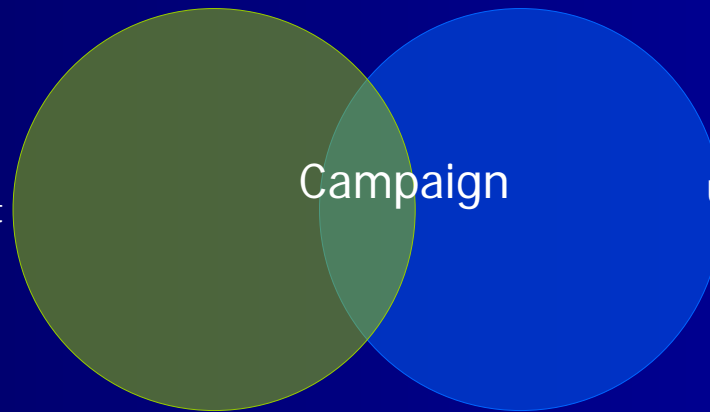
LHS Associates Business Model

- **Business #1, Programming Elections:** With their first line of business, LHS Associates alone has access to and control over the *secret vote counting software* that counts 81% of NH's votes.
- **Business #2, Collecting Census Data:** With their second line of business, LHS Associates performs what is known as "data mining". They collect census data, information about who lives where, what are their incomes, their professions, their habits, their properties, their family histories.

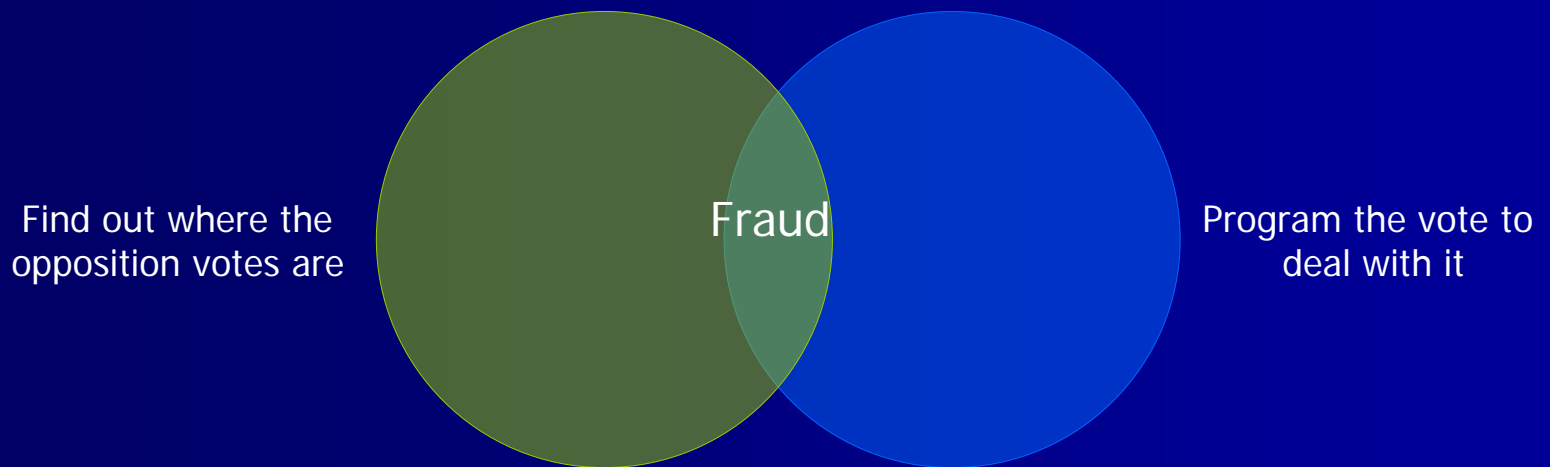

The not so legitimate intersection: Election Programming



Florida 2000 Presidential Election: ChoicePoint, a data mining company, helped out George Bush's campaign by systematically stripping out (purging) 94,000 eligible voters - all identified as Democrat-leaning - from the voter registration rolls. They were denied their right to vote in that election.

All Diebold All the Time

- In 2004 the NH legislature, with the support of the Secretary of State, legislated redesign of the NH ballot.
- The law was written on the advice and consultancy of LHS Associates, Diebold Election Systems vendor for New England.
- LHS Associates advised the state that Diebold optical scanners were the only voting machine that could read the new ballot design.
- Additionally, LHS informed the state that the existing firmware in NH's Diebold equipment needed to be replaced with new firmware to read the ballots.
- The state paid for the replacement of ES&S equipment with Diebold for twenty five NH towns, as well as replacement firmware for every Diebold voting machine in the state.

Cost of Ballot Redesign

- The ballot redesign legislation engineered by LHS Associates, the Secretary of State, and the Legislature brought the following results:
 - Statewide Diebold-only vote counting computers using newly upgraded fraud-friendly software
 - At least \$135,000 to the bank accounts of LHS Associates for the switchover alone
